MUMM NAPA BRUT PRESTIGE NAPA VALLEY

Profile: Bright citrus, red apple, stone fruit and creamy vanilla. These vibrant flavors are balanced by fine acidity and a rich, lingering finish.

About: Established in California in the late 1970s, Mumm Napa follows traditional wine making techniques of its French heritage to create the finest, hand-crafted sparkling wines. Named for its founding company GH Mumm, Mumm Napa eventually built its estate vineyard in the beautiful Carneros region of Napa Valley. Mumm Napa holds true to founding winemaker Guy Devaux's original vision of creating the best possible sparkling wines in the United States.

ZACA MESA, VIOGNIER, 2015 SANTA YNEZ VALLEY, CA

Profile: This viognier jumps out of the glass with honeysuckles and ripe peaches. The palate has notes of peach pit, ripe apricot, sweet citrus and a lingering touch of minerality from their sand-loam soils.

About: Zaca Mesa's wines are made from sustainably farmed grapes that are estate grown, produced and bottled. With over 40 years of grape growing experience in the Santa Ynez Valley, their winemaking and vineyard team meticulously farm their vineyard to focus on terroir-driven wines. They began growing Rhone varieties in 1978, which are best suited for their estate and Santa Barbara County.

FERRARI-CARANO, PINOT GRIGIO RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY

Profile: A refreshing and light-bodied white wine that is perfect as an apéritif. This wine has delicious aromas and flavors of green apple, melon, white peach, lime, apricots, Meyer lemon, and a hint of honeyed lychee and orange blossom. This Pinot Grigio is bright and crisp with full, concentrated flavors that linger to the finish.

About: Since 1985, Ferrari-Carano has been a leading producer of world-class, nationally-acclaimed wines. Vintage after vintage, the wines exhibit a remarkable consistency of style and elegance.

CHALEUR ESTATE DELILLE, SAUVIGNON BLANC WASHINGTON STATE

Profile: An expressive bouquet of smoky herbs, grasses, elegant white flowers and honey butter, citrus oil with nuances of creamy vanilla brioche, golden apples and toast. In the mouth there are generous proportions of star fruit, guava, meyer lemon, apples, lime leaves and cream. Mouthwatering acidity, beautiful structure and balance carrying through to a lengthy finish.

About: In 1994 they were fortunate to acquire the rights to Harrison Hill vineyard which had some of the oldest vines in the state. Now over 50 years old, Harrison Hill has become one of the most sought after Bordeaux blends in the state.

HANZELL, CHARDONNAY SONOMA VALLEY

Profile: Exquisite aromas of Bosc pear, green mango, lemon zest and jasmine mingle with scents reminiscent of brioche, anise and dusty slate. The taught structure gives the sense of a lighter weight.

About: For over fifty years, Hanzell Vineyards has grown, produced and bottled Chardonnay and Pinot Noir, which have the unique distinction of being produced solely from estate-grown fruit since 1961.

MINUTY, ROSÉ CÔTE DE PROVENCE, FRANCE

Profile: The aromatic harmony of grenache and cinsault offers some notes of peach and candied orange. The mouth is fresh and round.

About: The Matton-Farnets have been in the wine industry for almost three centuries, beginning at the Domaine de Châteauneuf in Vidauban, and continuing at Château Minuty from 1936 where Gabriel Farnet, the grandfather of François and Jean-Etienne, the current owners, set up. Gabriel Farnet replanted the entire wine estate and returned Château Minuty to its former glory.

FERRARI-CARANO, PINOT NOIR ANDERSON VALLEY

Profile: Aromas of pretty raspberry, cherry, pomegranate, a touch of rose petal, and cola notes fill the senses followed by vibrant flavors of red fruits that jump out on the front palate, while the mid-palate turns to blackberry, plum and spice notes. The finish is fruit driven with lingering flavors of cherry and a spicy touch of toast.

About: Don and Rhonda Carano's uncompromising commitment to quality and excellence is a reflection of their desire to produce memorable wines that enhance the pleasures of gracious entertaining.

SIENA, FERRARI-CARANO, RED BLEND SONOMA COUNTY

Profile: Delicious aromas of pomegranate, cherry, plum, licorice and mocha. Flavors of strawberry jam on the entry are enhanced by cherry cola and smoky plums that add layers of richness to this elegant wine. SIENA has supple tannins that leave a balanced mouthfeel with lively elegance, depth and a lingering finish.

SALDO, ZINFANDEL CALIFORNIA

Profile: The wine displays a dark ruby color with bold aromas of blackberry, plum and clove. The entry is rich and full, with juicy acidity encircled in flavors of Mexican chocolate, cherry and vanilla extract. There is a voluptuous and persistent finish with smooth tannins.

About: With over a decade of winemaking experience at Paso Robles' prestigious Wild Horse Winery, Winemaker Chrissy Wittmann leads The Prisoner winemaking team who along with our family of growers, work together to craft our selection of distinctly stylistic wines.

CARPE DIEM, CABERNET SAUVIGNON NAPA VALLEY

Profile: The wine is fruit forward, elegant, and exhibits soft tannins, making it pleasant to drink in its youth. Oak is used sparingly to keep Carpe Diem fresh and vibrant. It is a refreshing and straightforward wine expressing its bountiful fruit with bright aromas of wild strawberries and soft tannins.

About: Grapes for the Carpe Diem Cabernet Sauvignon have been selected exclusively from the best vineyards in world-renowned Napa Valley. Vinified under the strict supervision of Christian Moueix's winemaking team in Yountville, California, Carpe Diem embodies the essence of Napa Valley classic Cabernet Sauvignon.
