The versatile halls at the Gran Hotel Inglés allow you to hold events, meetings or parties fully adapted to your needs.

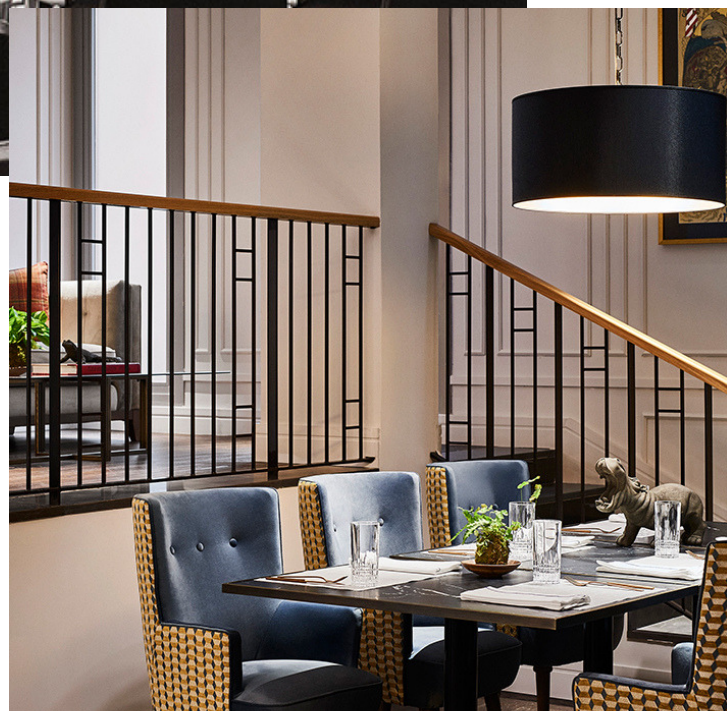

MEETINGS & EVENTS AT GRAN HOTEL INGLÉS

This space is a tribute to the many literary meetings and artistic conversations that took place in this hotel at the end of the 19th century. The peaceful atmosphere invites you to read and reflect.

Our two private dining areas - which together measure more than 40 m² - make it possible for you to host any kind of Madrid event, whether it's a company dinner, a meal with friends, or a birthday celebration.

Flexible conference room and event spaces, the two meeting rooms available at the Gran Hotel Inglés can be used separately or jointly, with the latter option offering more than 90 m² of space. They are the best space in this Madrid business hotel in which to hold your company's meetings or events. Preceding these rooms is an entrance hall measuring more than 50 m²: enough space to organise a cocktail reception of any kind before the event itself. These spaces feature the latest in audiovisual equipment which, along with the hotel's staff, will ensure your conference or event is a runaway success.



ROYAL SUITE

25 m2 on the hotel's top floor. The Royal Suite has two separate entrances, one that leads onto the main rooms, the master bedroom, the bathroom and dressing room, and a second one that leads onto another large bedroom.

The Royal Suite has 2 separate bedrooms, large living areas, a dining room for several people, 3 televisions, an area with a vintage bar to mix exclusive cocktails, a butler service available on request, and two 20s style freestanding bathtubs under the traditional sloping ceilings, typical of Madrid's most exclusive 19th Century architecture. It is a luminous and tranquil space, a feast for the senses, evoking the exquisite elegance of the luxury and sophisticated lifestyles enjoyed by the European aristocracy at the Gran Hotel Inglés in the roaring 20s.



PRESIDENTIAL SUITE

This magnificent 93 m2 suite is located on the hotel's top floor. It features elegant private spaces that look out on the hotel's grand central courtyard on one side and Calle Echegaray on the other. The Presidential suite comprises a separate bedroom, living area, work area, living room with a sofa, chaise longue, reading area, dining area for several guests, an antique bar for you to prepare a cocktail, and a freestanding 1920s-style bathtub. You'll find all of this beneath one of the 4 extant mansard roofs that characterise the most refined architecture of the 19th century, with a style unique to any other 5 star hotel in Madrid, Spain.



ECHEGARAY SUITE

Bathed in warm natural light, our Echegaray suites, spread over 60m², offer two possible distributions with capacity to accommodate the whole family: Two independent rooms connected by a common access lobby or a room connected to a spacious living room. An exclusive location looking out over Calle Echegaray, where you can gaze out and watch life passing by in the Barrio de las Letras, as well as the hotel's exquisite interior courtyard. It has two televisions, one in the living room and another in the bedroom, a freestanding bathtub and sophisticated art deco details that evoke the elegant lifestyle of the roaring 20s.



MELLER SUITE

One of the most exclusive spaces in the best boutique hotel in Madrid. The 50 m2 Meller suite is designed to be the perfect place to relax and get away from it all. Located on the fourth floor, it boasts a private terrace with a Jacuzzi that looks out on the hotel's quiet central courtyard. Inside, this luxury suite in the heart of Madrid features separate bedroom and cosy living areas and a freestanding bathtub. And added to all of this are meticulous, exquisite art deco details.
