Where are the Whitsundays?

The Whitsundays are located along Queensland's central coast in north-eastern Australia, approximately 1,120km north of Brisbane and 630km south of Cairns. The Whitsundays region includes 74 magnificent islands with the large majority of these uninhabited. The major towns nearest on the mainland are Airlie Beach, Bowen, Proserpine and Mackay.

A bit about the Island...

Daydream Island is approximately 1km from north to south and 400m east to west at its widest point. The highest point on the island is 51m above sea level.

The main area of the resort is positioned toward the north of the island with additional event spaces on the south end. The island offers established walking tracks through the naturally leafy western side where guests can take in the stunning views from our purpose built viewing deck. Access around the island is easily done by foot.

The island underwent an extensive 2 year refurbishment prior to its reopening in April 2019. The \$100m project provides upgraded accommodation and event rooms, installation of new features and upgrades of existing attractions, reopening as a 4 ½ star resort.



How to get to Daydream Island

There are 2 airports that service the region, both serviced by major airlines including Virgin, Qantas and Jetstar.

Hamilton Island Airport (HTI) has direct flights from Cairns, Brisbane, Sydney and Melbourne and is a direct 30 minute boat transfer to Daydream Island.

Alternatively, Proserpine Airport (PPP) is a 40km road transfer to Port of Airlie then a 30 minute boat transfer direct to Daydream Island.

Boat transfers to Daydream Island are provided by Cruise Whitsundays on their fleet of purpose built, modern vessels. All boat transfers are scheduled to coincide with arriving and departing flights from both airports.



Whitsundays Weather

The region has a tropical climate of hot summers, warm winters with bright spring and autumn days. Average daily temperatures range at around 22-23 in the winter months and up to 29-30 in the summer months. The tropical wet season occurs January through March when days can get steamy with high humidity and the summer heat is often broken by tropical rain fall.

Mother nature can be a little unpredictable year round, so any event booked into an outdoor space on Daydream Island will always have an indoor space on hold in case it is required.

Accommodation Overview

Daydream Island offers a total of 277, well appointed, refurbished rooms and suites.

All Superior, Deluxe and Suite rooms open to a balcony or patio and contain either a king bed or two queen beds.

All rooms contain STD/ISD phones, flat screen wall mounted TV, radio, tea/coffee making facilities, mini bar, iron/ironing board, hair dryer, reverse cycle air conditioning, safe box, clock radio with Bluetooth connectivity, office desk with chair. All rooms are serviced daily with an Eco Friendly opt out option available.

Rollaway beds are permitted within King rooms only, with the exception of Deluxe Rooms.

Check in is 2pm. Check out is 10am.



Standard Rooms

Conveniently located close to the central Atrium building, featuring views out to the resort. The bathroom contains a shower over the bath with Eco friendly amenities.

Superior Rooms

Featuring sliding doors that open to a balcony this room type has 3 different aspects – Poolside, Pool View and Ocean View. The bathroom contains a shower over the bath with Eco friendly amenities.

Deluxe Ocean Terrace

Facing directly over the ocean towards the Whitsunday Islands, these rooms are located on the eastern side of the Driftwood Wing. All rooms feature a larger terrace with outdoor furniture. The bathroom contains a walk in shower with Eco friendly amenities.

Horizon Room

Eclipse Room and Terrace

Located on level 2 of the main building facing west, the Eclipse room is an indoor space that has an expansive outdoor terrace ideal for conference break catering or pre dinner drinks. This space is airconditioned, spacious and needs very little theming to create one of the most unique event experiences Daydream Island offers. Ideal for a VIP experience and suitable for a maximum of 30 guests.

Main Pool

Overlooking the white coral beach of Mermaids Beach and the main guest pools at the north of the island, this poolside location offers the ideal outdoor location for casual events such as cocktail parties. An expansive paved and grassed area offers a range of additional set up options and for those large events, Mermaids Beach can be included.

Mermaids Beach

Our premier beach location for your outdoor event. The white coral beach at the northern end of the island overlooks the Whitsundays and is the perfect place for a casual beach bbq or a cocktail event. For larger events our main pool area can be included to expand the area.

Open Air Cinema Lawn


Well over 100,000 people visit the Great Barrier Reef each year to experience the largest reef ecosystem in the world. Did you know that Sawfishes are the most endangered rays in the world? The freshwater (or largetooth) sawfish *Pristis pristis* which SARA work with, is considered to be amongst 100 most threatened species in the world.

Daydream Islands Living Reef is home to a number of sharks and rays including Bamboo Sharks, Blacktip Reef Sharks, Shovelnose Rays, Estuary Rays, Whitetail Whip Rays and more. We welcome our guests to engage with our Marine Biologist team to learn more about these amazing species. Sharks and Rays play an extremely important role in maintaining balance in our local marine ecosystems.

Want to go above and beyond? We can assist in coordinating a range of additional activities that will have your delegates engaging in a positive contribution to the preservation of the Great Barrier Reef as well as other fantastic causes. Some of these options include;

- Participate in an environmental clean up in a selected location options within The Whitsundays

Living Reef

The Living Reef is a free form coral lagoon that wraps 200m around the central building and is home to over 100 species of local coral, fish, small sharks, rays and other reef dwelling creatures.

Utilising 1.5m litres of water this man made reef system offers a range of ways for your guests to get up close to our resident marine animals. The new Underwater Observatory is 4m under water and showcases a large 7x3m window where you can watch the marine life going about their day. Also a new addition is the Education Centre that has 8 living displays showcasing various habitats from mangroves to corals and an interactive touch pool.

Our range of Living Reef activities can be customised to suit corporate groups of all sizes for exclusive activity options that will contribute to their island experienced.

For the comfort and positive experience of all guests of Daydream Island, all venues have noise curfews and dB limits. Live or amplified music is not permitted at all venues. Please consult your Events contact for the most up to date relevant venue information.



Corporate Social Responsibility

Daydream Island Resort is governed by the Great Barrier Reef Marine Park Authority (GBRMPA) and Environmental Protection Authority (EPA). Our commitment to the rules set out by these bodies is something Daydream is seriously committed to, to continually ensure we are following best practice for environmental sustainability and protection.

Water

Daydream recognises the dire drought situation affecting many areas of Australia and are making every effort to conserve this precious resource in our every day operation of the island through a number of initiatives;

- Giving guests the option to have towels and bedding not replaced daily, leading to reduced laundry washing
- Waste water is recycled through our sewerage treatment facility and is used on gardens
- Routine maintenance of all taps to ensure leaks are fixed promptly
- All accommodation rooms fitted with water saving showerheads
- Encouraging staff and guests to reduce their shower time. Did you know each minute of showering uses around 10 litres of water?
- Toilets are all fitted with optional half flush water saving function

Power

In a conscious effort to reduce energy consumption;

- Where possible and suitable, energy efficient lights are in place
- Encouraging guests and staff to turn off light switches, tv's, computers when not in use
- Ensuring air conditioning filters are regularly cleaned to ensure systems are not running harder than necessary
- Encouraging all manually controlled air conditioning systems to be maintained at 23 degrees, to reduce overuse
- Installing insulation in all buildings to reduce need for air-conditioning
- In our kitchens, ensuring fridges and freezers are kept at optimal temperatures and doors and seals are in perfect working order
- All appliances have best suitable energy consumption rating

Reduce, Reuse, Recycle

Aiming to reduce landfill contribution, Daydream Island undertakes many initiatives including;

- Separating general rubbish and all recyclable materials such as plastic, paper, glass, cardboard, aluminium cans
- Engine oil, paints and other chemicals are removed by certified waste management contractors for correct disposal
- Green waste from pruned and fallen trees and foliage is mulched and used in garden beds
- Rubbish compactor is used on site to minimise volume of rubbish needing to be removed by barge, therefore reducing barge travel
- Plastic single use straws are not available
- Avoiding the use of disposable cups, plates, cutlery, napkins where possible and using reusable crockery, glassware, plastics and silver wear
- Banning single use plastic bags and offering reusable cloth bags at retail outlets
- Used cooking oils are removed by certified contractors and reused as a bio fuel in lieu of diesel
