It is with a heavy heart and thoughtful consideration that we announce we will not be allowing guests to visit the resort between this Sunday, March 22<sup>nd</sup> and April 30<sup>th</sup>. This decision was made Wednesday, March 19<sup>th</sup> after much in-house discussion. We take Governor Walz's words seriously when he discouraged non-essential travel, asked for personal sacrifice and is asking all Minnesotans to act quickly. We believe that this is the best way we can do our part to slow down the rapid progression of the coronavirus.

All reservations between those times will be cancelled and fully refunded or moved to a later date.
