Guest Reception

Our Guest Reception is open 9am-5pm through the winter season. Dial “O” from your room phone to speak to our front desk team.

Resort Facilities

Our upper pool and hot tub are heated and open 9am-10pm daily. Just take your room key to access the upper pool area and fresh towels from your room.

Housekeeping Services

Due to COVID-19 restrictions our housekeeping staff will not be able to enter your unit to clean during your stay. If you need extra supplies such as coffee or towels, please call reception between 9:30am-5.00pm and we will be able to drop these off for you.

Covid-19 Restricted Services

Due to the COVID-19 restrictions the Spa, Steam Cave and Gym remain closed this winter. Our pool and hot tub will remain open.

Feeling the cold?

To operate the fireplace: Press and hold the “OFF” button and the top button at the same time. A beep will sound for approximately 6 seconds and the fire mechanism will click. Immediately release both buttons. The beeping will continue for about 10 seconds and then the fireplace will turn on.

Using the thermostat: You should see a thermostat on your wall that controls the room heat. The heating turns off if the room gets too hot so we recommend keeping at warm temperature but not like summer in the Bahamas.

What's the weather like?

Visit us at reception for your daily weather update!

November average temperature is 43.5°F with an average high of 48.5°F and an average low of 38.4. Average Precipitation 6.

December average temperature of 39.7°F with an average high of 48.5°F and an average low of 35.1°F. Average Precipitation 4.7

January average temperature is 40.8°F with an average high of 45.6°F and an average low of 36°F. Average Precipitation 5.8.

Where can we eat?

At Poets Cove our restaurants close October 19th (closes after lunch) and re-open in February. All villas and cottages have fully equipped kitchens. Our café will close October 18th.

The nearest supermarket is the TruValue located at the Driftwood Shopping Centre on North Pender (17 mins drive away).
