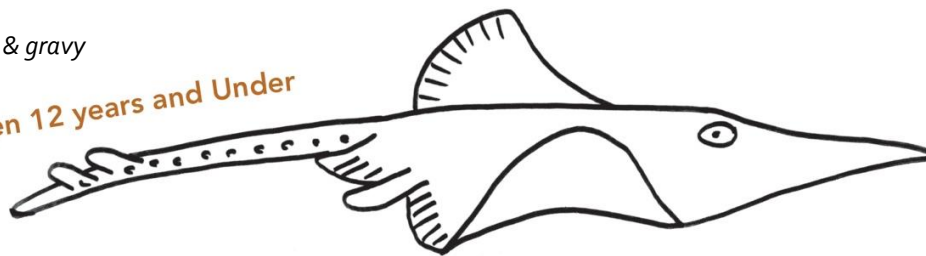
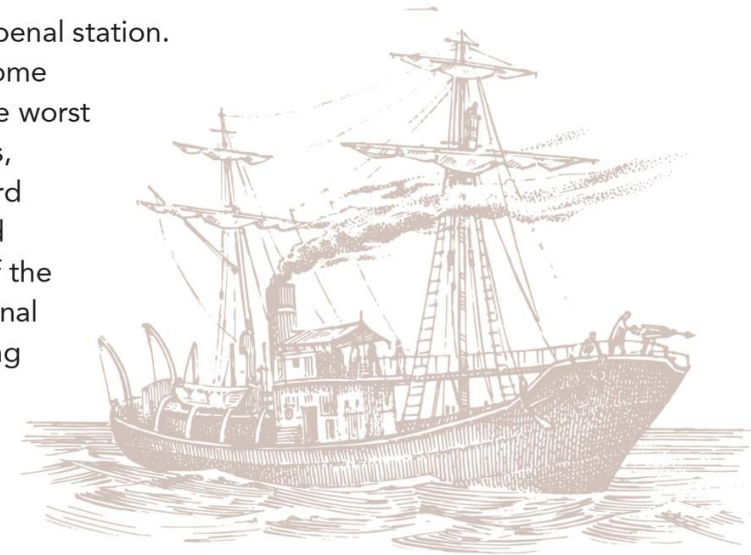

SARAH ISLAND

– the Macquarie Harbour Penal Station

Sarah Island was the site of Tasmania's first penal station. Established in 1822, the station had a fearsome reputation as a brutal place, reserved for the worst convicts. The men endured harsh conditions, ferocious punishments, and long days of hard labour, hauling and cutting the highly prized Huon pine. Shipping the valuable timber off the island proved difficult, and over time the penal station developed into a thriving shipbuilding site and industrial village. A total of 113 ships were built here, 80 of which were completed between 1828 and 1832.



Did you know?

Macquarie Harbour has its very own Skate?

Also known as the Maugean skate (*Zearaja maugeana*), it is only found in Macquarie Harbour. Even though it's thought that the species has been thriving in Tasmanian waters since Gondwana times, it was only discovered in 1988! It has a large, flat body shaped like a quadrangle, and dark brown skin patterned with pale cream blotches. They use their huge pectoral fins and smaller pelvic fins to propel themselves along the sea bed at great speed.
