GOLF MONT GABRIEL'S COMMITMENT TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH'S MEASURES

May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021

Golf Mont Gabriel is committed to providing a safe environment for its golfers and its employees. In addition to the golfer's usual ethics of fostering respect and social distancing, the following measures have been added to ensure the safety of all. This list is not exhaustive and is subject to change as the pandemic situation develops

- Spaced out departure times;
- Customers cannot arrive more than 30 minutes before the scheduled departure time;
- Only four people are allowed to use the practice green for 15 minutes at a time;
- One mound out of two is available for use at the practice net;
- One person at a time is allowed inside the golf shop as well as one person in each bathroom;
- Please note that we ask you to favor payment by card and not cash;
- The only bathrooms available are those of the golf shop and that of the Tee Bar. These are disinfected regularly;
- Self-shopping inside the pro shop is prohibited. Our associates will be happy to assist you in your efforts;
- Scorecards and pencils are available on request;
- The Food & Beverage outlets on the course are closed;
- Water fountains and jugs are not accessible on the course or at the golf shop. Be sure to arrive with a full bottle or shop at the store before you leave;
- The carts are disinfected between each customer and wiped down to be sanitized.
- The carts can be shared by people living at the same address with a photo ID. For other customers, carts with dividers will be available;
- The cups are equipped with a handle to pick up the ball without contact;
- It is forbidden to remove the flag from the cup;
- The rakes have been removed from the sand traps. Please replace the sand with your foot;
- At the end of your game, you must leave the area and avoid loitering;

Also, for the respect of all, we ask you to respect the distance of 2 meters with our staff and other golfers, personal protective equipment such as plexiglass, gloves, masks and visors as well as to wash your hands regularly.
