WHERE?

Strahan is situated on Tasmania's West Coast, approximately 5 hours from Hobart or 4 hours from Launceston. It offers access to one of the last great expanses of temperate rain forest found on the planet.

OUR FAVOURITE ACTIVITIES

Gordon River Cruises - No visit to Tasmania's West Coast is complete without experiencing the award-winning cruise on the majestic waters of the Gordon River and Macquarie Harbour.

The Ship That Never Was - Sit back and enjoy a great evening's entertainment and discover some of the West Coast's fascinating history at the same time, at Australia's longest-running play.

West Coast Wilderness Railway - A must do experience for any visitor to the west coast. This heritage stream train journey takes you through otherwise inaccessible Tasmanian rainforest and wilderness landscapes on your journey between Strahan and Queenstown.

The Pillinger Explorer – Explore the wilderness of Pillinger on the shores of Macquarie Harbour with this small-group tour. Learn about the 'boom and bust' history of this remarkable place, that has now been reclaimed by the rainforest.

RoamWild – Join a small group tour with RoamWild, to venture into ancient mines, scale mountain peaks and discover the hidden treasures of the west coast.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: What is the Strahan Village Address for my GPS?

A: 41 Esplanade, Strahan.

Q: How long will it take to drive to Strahan?

A: From Hobart is 300km / 45.-5 hours, Cradle Mountain is 137km / 3 hours, Devonport is 224km / 2.5 hours and from Launceston, 272km / 4 hours.

Q: What do 'Village' and 'Hilltop' mean?

A: Some rooms are located at the same level as the Strahan Esplanade and waterfront (Village) and others at the top of the hill overlooking Macquarie Harbour (Hilltop).

Q: Will my mobile phone work in Strahan?

A: Only Telstra's network works in Strahan. Optus works in Zeehan and Queenstown.

Q: Do rooms have a minibar?

A: Only our Village Waterfront Executive Rooms have mini bars. Mini bars can be provided in other rooms on request.

Q: What's the weather like on Tasmania's west coast?

A: The weather can change in the blink of an eye, so it's best to bring plenty of layers just in case!
