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1 PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION AND PRIVACY POLICY

1.1 PRIVACY STATEMENT

This privacy statement (hereinafter "Statement") is valid for WOW Hotels & Convention Center operated by MAPA İnş. ve Tic. A.Ş., its affiliated groups and companies and all hotels in its portfolio (hereinafter "WOW"). How the data collected during your visit to WOW's website and while you benefit from the services offered will be used and protected is subject to the conditions in this "Privacy Policy". We hereby state that you are deemed to have understood and accepted the conditions of "Privacy Policy" as a result of your request to benefit from WOW services or your visit to the website.

1.1.1 PURPOSE OF THE POLICY OF PROTECTING AND PROCESSING THE PERSONAL DATA

Protection of the personal data is the basic policy of our company. We undertake to comply with all responsibilities contemplated by the Law on the Protection of Personal Data no. 6698 and applicable law (foreign or domestic). We collect your personal data in accordance with the law, and keep according to this privacy policy and the law. Such personal data may include: your name, surname, e-mail address, phone number, mailing address, billing address, reservation, information about your accommodation or visit; whether you are a participant in a marketing or fair program (even if you do not accommodate in any of our hotels); information regarding your product or service purchase; guest preferences; marketing and communication preferences; information regarding the items which you may bring to our facilities; your personal features, nationality, income, passport number and date and place of issue; your travel history; payment card number and other card information and identity authentication information for mobile billing and the payment information such as other billing and account information; your evaluation and opinions about our facilities and brand; the groups you are associated with in order to accommodate in the hotels, information related to conversations including recording or monitoring the customer services calls and in-app messages and other messages such as SMS for quality assurance and training purpose and other information which you prefer giving us or we may obtain".

WOW processes the personal and private personal data according and limited to the data processing conditions and objectives specified in the law.

Your personal data collected:

- a. To enable WOW to carry out the relevant activities for processing your personal and private personal data and as it is clearly stipulated in the laws
- b. As processing your personal data by WOW is directly associated with and required for establishing or executing a contract
- c. As it is necessary and required for WOW to fulfill its legal liabilities

- d. To process the personal data limited to the relevant information provided that it is made public by the relevant person
- e. As it is required to establish, use and protect the rights of WOW, relevant person or third parties
- f. As it is required to process the data for legitimate interests of WOW provided that the basic rights and liberties of the relevant persons are not prejudiced
- g. As processing is required to protect the life or body integrity of the relevant person or another person, or as the relevant person can not express his/her consent due to actual and legal invalidity
- h. As it is stipulated in the laws for the private personal data of the relevant person other than his/her health and sexual life
- i. To process the private personal data of the relevant person regarding his/her health and sexual life by the persons under confidentiality obligation or the authorized bodies and institutions for the purpose of protecting the public health, performing the preventive medicine, medical diagnosis, treatment and care services, planning and managing the healthcare services and financing
- j. To enable WOW's business units to perform the necessary studies and carry out the activities accordingly so that WOW's commercial activities are carried out according to the regulations and WOW policies
- k. To determine, plan and implement short, medium and long term commercial policies of WOW
- l. To design and conduct Human Resources activities of WOW
- m. To support Mng Holding Group Companies for designing, planning and conducting the Human Resources activities
- n. To ensure the commercial and legal safety of Mng Holding and the natural persons with whom WOW has business relations
- o. To protect the trust established by commercial reputation of Mng Holding and WOW is processed according to the basic principles set forth by KVK Law and under the terms and conditions of processing personal data specified in article 5 and 6 of the law.

1.1.2 SCOPE OF THE POLICY OF PROTECTING AND PROCESSING THE PERSONAL DATA

The Policy applies to all personal data of WOW Personnel and Prospective Personnel, Suppliers, Guests receiving service, accommodating or non-accommodating, employees of the cooperated organizations, processed automatically or non-automatically.

1.2 DEFINITIONS

1.2.1 PERSONAL DATA:

It means any information regarding a natural person who is or may be identified. Name, surname, place and date of birth, physical, family, economic and other features, and name, phone number,

motor vehicle license plate number, social security number, passport number etc. are personal data. In this sense, personal data is required to have tangible characteristics which express the physical, economic, cultural, social or psychological identity of the person, or be identifying as a result of associating with any record such as personal, tax, security number etc.

1.2.2 PRIVATE PERSONAL DATA:

It includes the race, ethnic origin, political opinion, philosophical belief, religion, sect or other beliefs, appearance, foundation or union membership, health, sexual life, conviction and security measures related data and biometric and genetic data of people. In the Law, private personal data is defined by limitation, and it is not possible to extend by analogy.

1.2.3 EXPRESS CONSENT:

It should be understood as the statement of approval of the Related Person to have his/her data processed, which is given freely, after being sufficiently informed, clearly leaving no room for doubt and limited only to that process.

1.2.4 RELATED PERSON:

Natural person whose personal data is processed

1.2.5 ANONYMIZATION:

It means making the data non-relatable with any natural person who is or may be identified even if the data is matched with other data.

3.6 Processing the Personal Data:

Personal data may be processed as follows.

- a. Collecting or recording: Processing starts as of the moment of first obtaining the personal data.
- b. Organizing –Archiving: Saving, keeping or storing the personal data in digital or physical media
- c. Using – Changing: Any use of the personal data including viewing.
- d. Transfer: Transferring the personal data by various methods
- e. Dissemination – Making Available: Making the data accessible by 3rd parties in digital media such as physical distribution or sharing
- f. Prevention/Deletion/Destruction/Anonymization

- g. Automatic Processing: Data processing activity which minimizes the need of human intervention or assistance and is performed by an inter-connected or interactive electrical or electronic system.
- h. Non-Automatic Processing (as a part of Data Record System): Data processing activity performed physically apart from information systems

1.2.6 DATA RECORD SYSTEM:

A record system where the personal data is configured and processed according to certain criteria electronically or physically.

1.2.7 DATA CONTROLLER:

Natural person or legal entity that determines the objectives and means of personal data processing, and is in charge of establishment and management of the data record system.

1.2.8 DATA PROCESSOR:

Natural person or legal entity that processes the personal data on behalf of the Data Controller by the authority granted.

1.3 PRINCIPLES:

WOW undertakes that it complies with the principles of observing the law and good faith, being accurate and updated when required, being specific, clear and for legitimate purposes and related to such purposes, limited and prudent, keeping for the period stipulated in the regulations or required for the purposes of data processing, taking and implementing the necessary technical and regulatory measures, protecting against unauthorized or illegal processing and accidental loss, destruction or demolition, and ensuring the safety of the data processed while it processes the personal data pursuant to the Law no. 6698.

1.4 IMPLEMENTATION:

1.4.1 ABBREVIATIONS:

Personal Data Protection Board: Board

WOW Personal Data Protection Committee: Committee

Law on the Protection of Personal Data: KVK Law

WOW receives the data of the Guests such as name, address, payment information, travel document information for the reservation procedures and completes the reservation process for the purpose of meeting, customizing the requests and expectations regarding the services offered and conducting the marketing and sales activities. Personal data received is processed according to the communication preferences. Appropriate marketing messages are sent where permitted.

Personal Data may also be used to improve the services offered, to organize and watch the content of the website correctly and clearly, and to offer hospitality at the expected level.

It keeps the data up-to-date.

Persons whose data is processed have the following rights;

- a. Information Right: It is important that the related persons know which personal data is processed. They may use their legal rights or comment on the consequence of the personal data accordingly.
- b. Right of Access: WOW shall give a copy of the personal data processed to the related persons who use their information right upon their request. Use of this right shall not negatively affect the rights and liberties of others.
- c. Right to Demand Correction: Pursuant to accuracy principle, data processed should be accurate in order to be accepted lawful. Accordingly, the related person has the right to demand from WOW the correction of the inaccurate personal data without any delay. Besides, he/she may also demand the completion of the missing data.
- d. Right to Demand Deletion: Related person may demand the deletion of the personal data processed illegally, missing or inaccurate. Data which is no longer required to be processed should also be deleted without the need to demand. If the related person uses his/her right to demand deletion, the data should be immediately deleted except the legal requirements and exceptions. WOW shall inform all state institutions and organizations to which the relevant data is disclosed and all other data controllers processing such data that the related party has used such right. However, if processing is required for public interest, establishment of a right, fulfillment of a duty or the use of an official right granted to WOW, this right is not applied.
- e. Right to Demand Limitation: If the related person objects to the accuracy of the personal data, he/she may demand from WOW the limitation of his/her data processed for a period in which the accuracy of the data can be confirmed. That is to say, information for which limitation is requested shall be marked, and it shall be updated, processed or proceeded as per the request when the consequence is designated. Besides, he/she may object to the use of the personal or private personal data collected automatically for direct marketing or profiling, and demand limitation for such data. If he/she incurs loss as a result of unlawful processing of personal data, he/she has the right to demand compensation for such loss.
- f. Right to Demand Notification: Related person has the right to demand notification about 3rd parties to whom his/her personal data is transferred as well as the rights to demand deletion, destruction of the personal data. Upon request, WOW informs the related person about his/her data transferred.

- g. Data Portability Right: Related person has the right to request a machine-readable copy of his/her personal data submitted to WOW and to transfer such data to another data controller when required to establish or execute a contract or by means of an express consent or automatically.

Related person may fill in the Application Form available at WOW's website or fill in the relevant forms by the other methods determined by Personal Data Protection Board and sign and submit to WOW in order to use the rights explained above.

After filling in the form at <https://www.wowhotelsistanbul.com/kvkkbasvuruform>, an original signed copy can be delivered by hand or sent through the notary public to "WOW İstanbul Otelleri ve Kongre Merkezi, Yeşilköy Mahallesi, Atatürk Caddesi, no: 15-17-19 34149 Bakırköy, İstanbul", or it can be sent by electronic mail to kvkk@wowhotelsistanbul.com after signing with secure electronic signature under Electronic Signature Law no. 5070.

WOW shall reply the requests sent within 30 business days under the law.

WOW may process the personal data in accordance with the law when required without the need for express consent. Such cases are clearly defined in the relevant law.

- Personal data of the person who is unable to express his/her consent due to actual impossibility or the person whose consent is not given legal validity may be processed without the need to receive consent when it is required to protect the life or body integrity of that person or others.
- Provided that it is directly related to the establishment or execution of a contract, when it is required to process the personal data of the contracting parties, it is not necessary to receive the consent of the related persons to process their personal data being limited to this purpose as per the ordinary course of life.
- Express consent of the related person is not required when it is essential to process data in order for the Data Controller to fulfill its legal liability.
- Consent is not required to process the personal data of the related person which is made public by the related person himself/herself, in other words, which is declared to the public by any means.
- Express consent of the related person is not required to process the personal data when it is essential to establish, use or protect a right.
- Express consent of the related person is not required to process the personal data when it is essential for legitimate interests of the data controller provided that the fundamental rights and freedoms of the related person are not damaged.
- Private personal data regarding the health and sexual life may be processed by the persons subject to confidentiality obligation or the authorized bodies and organizations without requiring consent only for the purpose of protecting the public health, performing the preventive medicine, medical diagnosis, treatment and care services, planning and managing the healthcare services and financing.

WOW makes the necessary legal inspections in the company or has them made. Results of the inspection are prepared and reported by the relevant departments and the relevant activities are conducted for the necessary measures and improvement.

WOW has established a system to inform the owner of the personal data and Personal Data Protection Board if the personal data processed is obtained by others illegally. If the Board requires, such situation shall be disclosed through the Board's website or by another method.

WOW has created Personal Data Protection Committee (hereinafter "Committee") in order to conduct the applicable administrative and technical arrangements for the purpose of evaluating the rights of the relevant persons and giving the necessary information.

When the related persons submit their requests to WOW in writing and according to the law, the Committee shall perform, follow-up and report all informing work.

The Committee is also in charge of organizing training in order to increase and sustain the whole work, including the measures taken, about the Law on the Protection of Personal Data and its content, and the employee awareness.

It is among the duties of the Committee to create awareness for WOW's Suppliers and Business Partners and to conduct related work. The Committee establishes and manages the systems required to periodically repeat the training of the relevant Business partners and the Suppliers when required and to create awareness for the current employees or new employees under the Law on the Protection of Personal Data.

The Committee reports to the Top Management the results of all training conducted to increase the awareness. Accordingly, it evaluates the participants of the training and seminars or information meetings, performs the inspections it deems necessary, and may have such inspections conducted by the professional companies if required.

The Committee updates the training and inspections as long as the relevant law regulations are updated.

WOW informs the data owners that the personal data processed is also processed for Accounting, Front Office, Human Resources, e-invoice and e-archive software used by all group companies of MNG Holding. Accordingly, it shares the "information text" about why the personal data is processed, to whom and for what reason the personal data processed may be transferred, data collection method and legal reasons and the rights of the data owner on the general areas, web page, visual and audial areas.

WOW may transfer the personal data processed legally, personal or private personal data of the relevant person to third parties after the necessary security measures are taken. Personal data may be transferred to the foreign countries which are determined by the Board to have sufficient protection or, in case of lack of sufficient protection, to the foreign countries which the Board allows and WOW undertakes to provide sufficient protection. While doing this, it complies with all regulations specified in KVK Law. It shall be transferred to foreign countries if,

- The related person has express consent

- There is sufficient protection for the issues specified in KVK Law (the conditions in article 5 paragraph 2 and article 6 paragraph 3) in the country to which data shall be transferred (countries accepted by the Board)
- The sufficient protection is undertaken in writing and the Board gives permission when there is not sufficient protection in the country to which data shall be transferred.

If there is sufficient protection in the country to which data shall be transferred, such transfer may be realized without receiving the relevant consent in the following cases under article 9 paragraph 2.

- Consent is not required to transfer the personal data abroad if it is clearly expressed in the laws
- it is essential for protecting the life or body integrity of a person who can not express his/her consent due to physical impossibility or whose consent is not given legal validity or of another person,
- it is required to process the personal data of the parties of a contract provided that it is directly related to the establishment and execution of the contract,
- it is essential for the data controller to fulfill its legal obligations,
- it is made public by the data subject himself/herself,
- it is essential to process the data for the establishment, use or protection of a right,
- it is essential to process the data for the legal benefits of the data controller provided that the fundamental rights and freedoms of the data subject are not damaged.

Similarly; data of the persons regarding their race, ethnic origin, political opinion, philosophical belief, religion, sect or other beliefs, appearance, association, foundation or trade union memberships, conviction and security measures and the biometric and genetic data may be transferred abroad if it is explicitly stipulated in the law.

Personal data of the persons regarding their health and sexual life may be transferred abroad by the persons under confidentiality obligation or the authorized bodies and institutions without express consent of the related person for the purpose of protecting the public health, performing the preventive medicine, medical diagnosis, treatment and care services, planning and managing the healthcare services and financing.

Article 9 of KVK Law allows the Board to approve or prohibit such data transfer if there is any possibility of serious impairment of the interests of Republic of Turkey or related person. Thus, the Board may implement this option when required.

1.5 WOW'S LIABILITIES:

1.5.1 INFORMING LIABILITY:

WOW has visually and audibly published the "Information Text" including the details regarding the personal data processed (<https://www.wowhotelsistanbul.com/kvkk/aydinlatmametni>) and other information in the general areas.

1.5.2 LIABILITIES FOR DATA SECURITY:

It undertakes to fulfill all liabilities of preventing the illegal processing of the personal data, preventing illegal access to such data and keeping it according to the laws. WOW has established a data recording system which determined the purposes and means of processing the personal data.

Joint Liability for Data Security:

WOW hereby agrees and undertakes that necessary measures shall be taken and it is jointly responsible if the data is processed by another real person or legal entity on its behalf.

1.5.3 LIABILITY FOR MAKING INSPECTION OR HAVING IT MADE:

While implementing the provisions of the law, WOW undertakes that it makes the necessary inspection / has the necessary inspection made in order to have the personal data processed according to the procedures and principles stipulated in the law.

1.5.4 CONFIDENTIALITY LIABILITY:

WOW undertakes that it shall not illegally disclose or make available to others the personal data processed except for the data for which information of transfer is given and the express consent is received. This commitment continues even after the data controller or data processors assigned at the time of processing leave.

1.5.5 LIABILITY OF NOTIFICATION IN CASE OF VIOLATION:

WOW shall immediately inform the related person and Board when the data processed is illegally obtained by others.

1.5.6 LIABILITY OF RESPONDING THE APPLICATIONS OF RELATED PERSONS AND FULFILLING THE BOARD DECISIONS:

WOW shall respond the requests submitted by the data owners in writing or by other methods determined by the Board for the implementation of the Law within the shortest time depending on the type of the request and within thirty days at the latest free of charge. If this process requires a cost, WOW may claim the charges specified in the Board's tariff from the requesting party. It may reject or accept the request specifying the reason. The replies may be sent in writing or electronically. If it accepts the request, it performs what is necessary, and if WOW's fault is found in the request, the charge received is returned.

If the request is rejected or the reply is found insufficient, or the reply is not given within due time, related person may inform the Board within the period specified in the law.

1.5.7 LIABILITY OF REGISTRATION IN DATA CONTROLLERS REGISTRY:

WOW shall complete its registration on the date and within the period announced by Personal Data Protection Board.

1.6 PROCEDURES UNDER THE LAW ON THE PROTECTION OF PERSONAL DATA FOR WOW EMPLOYEES AND PROSPECTIVE EMPLOYEES

WOW processes and protects the personal data of its employees for the employment period and for the legal keeping period after the employment period in order to meet the requests of competent bodies and organizations. For the Prospective Employees, it processes the personal data according to the job application forms or curriculum vitae sent in writing or electronically or the information sent through the employment and consultancy companies according to the nature of the work during the recruitment process. Such data is processed in order to evaluate the suitability of the prospective employee for the vacant positions, to confirm the accuracy of the information given, to keep in contact with the prospective employee during the process, and to improve recruitment processes and policies of WOW Human Resources Department.

WOW Employees and Prospective Employees are periodically informed about their collected and processed Personal and Private personal data and rights during the recruitment and employment period.

1.7 DATA CATEGORIES, KEEPING MEDIA AND PERIODS, DELETION-DESTRUCTION, ANONYMIZATION:

The list prepared regarding the category, purpose, keeping media, keeping period, deletion-destruction techniques of the personal and private personal data collected and processed by WOW as specified also in Registry is available in ANNEX1, and ANNEX1 is an integral part of this policy.

When the reasons requiring the process of the personal data are not available any more, WOW deletes, destructs or anonymizes such data ex officio or upon the request of the related person.

Deletion is the process of making the personal data inaccessible and non-reusable by the related users. Destruction is the process of making the all physical recording media where the data is kept irreversible and non-reusable. In other words, it means the destruction of the materials where the data is kept such as documents, files, CD, floppy disks, hard disks etc. Anonymization is making the

personal data unassociated with a natural person whose identity is or may be known even if it is matched with other data.

1.8 PROTECTING AND SECURING THE PERSONAL AND PRIVATE PERSONAL DATA:

WOW has taken the optimum technical and administrative measures according to the technological opportunities and budget costs in order to process the personal and private personal data according to the law.

All data processed is audited by the applications within the technical system and the additional measures required and the periodical controls of all system inspections are reported by the relevant unit within ISO Quality System. Employees with comprehensive knowledge, training and experience are employed within the system.

All employees are informed about the Law on the Protection of Personal Data no. 6698 and its implementation and they are periodically trained.

All work processes and instructions and job definitions are updated pursuant to the Law.

Contracts and documents between the employees and the company, except for the legal exceptions, have been updated with the articles detailing the liability of both parties (not processing, disclosing, using, sharing and transferring etc. the personal data except for the exceptions) and signed. Employees have been informed in detail as part of their training. Information about the Law on the Protection of Personal Data and its Implementation is included in WOW Orientation Training.

WOW has taken technical and administrative measures also to prevent the unauthorized sharing, access, transfer or other illegal access to the personal data processed.

It has taken the appropriate technological measures, and periodically follows the update and renewal of such measures. It has arranged the authorization of access and determined the limitations. Relevant authorization definitions are regularly reviewed.

Anti-virus, firewall and file management software and hardware are currently installed and managed by the expert employees. Security screening is made and caused to be made at regular intervals in order to reveal the security vulnerabilities regarding the Personal Data collected and to determined the possible security problems and to close the vulnerabilities found.

Employees are also trained that they shall not share the technical and administrative measures applied and the personal data they learn with others, and shall not use the same for the wrong purposes pursuant to KVK Law, otherwise, they shall be discharged and such liabilities shall continue even after they leave WOW. Required commitments are included in the employee contracts and signed.

The right of access to data, authorization levels have been determined and included in work processes.

Necessary technical and administrative measures have been taken in order to keep the Personal Data in secure medium. Security systems have been installed in the keeping areas and they are managed by the skilled personnel. Measures taken are periodically followed and reported. Backup systems have been installed, and secure protection has been supported. Authorization of access to data keeping areas and access information are logged and unauthorized access attempts or improper access information are followed and reported and the necessary measures are taken accordingly.

WOW undertakes that, if it is required to outsource service due to any technical necessity or when it shares or transfer the data as per the relevant purpose while processing, keeping, backing up and protecting the personal data, it shall comply with all agreements made with the relevant suppliers and business partners to whom the relevant data will be legally transferred, take / cause to be taken all necessary measures to protect the data of the data owners, and that such measures shall be complied with.

1.9 WOW WEB PAGE USE AND PURPOSES OF COOKIES

Cookies are the small pieces of text sent by the website visited to the browser. You can display our cookies at <https://www.wowhotelsistanbul.com> and also learn from the information in this text.

Cookies allow us to remember the information related to your visit (for example, preferred language and other settings) and to facilitate your next visit and to make the website more useful. If we did not use the cookies, the use of our website by you would be difficult.

We use the cookies for many reasons. For example, we use them to remember your secure search preferences, to determine how many visitors visited our web page and sub-pages, to facilitate the registration in our services, to protect your data or to remember your [advertisement settings](#).
