To make your visit more enjoyable and secure, please take a moment to review the following:

- ! Alcohol is not allowed on the beach, the sidewalks or in the parks.
- * Lock your car, take your keys and secure your valuables out of sight.
- * Always use the crosswalks when crossing the road. When driving, stop for pedestrians walking in the crosswalks.
- * Watch your children. Take a photo of what they are wearing before you arrive in the event you become separated.
- * No pets are allowed on the beach.
- * When thunder roars, go indoors. Get out of the water and off of the beach.
- * Don't leave your possessions on the beach.
- * Follow the lifeguard flags.
- * Florida's sunshine is intense. Drink water and wear sunscreen.
- * Broken glass and bare feet don't mix. Don't bring glass containers on the beach.
- * Fire damages our beautiful white sand. No BBQ's, grills or open flames are allowed.

What you can do to help

- * Don't litter! Dispose of the trash you create on the beach. If a trash receptacle is full, bring trash to the next empty receptacle.
- * Sand dunes protect the beach from erosion and are wildlife nesting areas. Do not walk on the sand dunes.
- * Seagulls love human food, but become accustomed to being fed by people and increase waste. Don't feed the birds.
