Privacy policy pursuant to article 13 of EU Regulation 679/2016

In accordance with Art. 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 (hereinafter "the Regulation"), we inform you that the personal data that you provide will be processed by our company so that you can register with and use the Wi-Fi service (also called the "**service**") available at our hotel facilities.

Your personal data will be stored in full compliance with the security measures required by the legislation on the protection of personal data and will be held until the end of your stay at our hotel facilities and when you consequently stop using the service.

Privacy laws (arts. 15-22 of the Regulation) guarantee you the right to access information concerning you at any time, to have it integrated and/or rectified, if it is inaccurate or incomplete, and to cancel it, if it has been processed unlawfully, and the right to the portability of the information you have provided, when processed using automated means for the contractual services you have requested, within the limits of the provisions of the Regulation (art. 20). Privacy laws also give you the right to limit data processing, if the conditions are met, and to oppose data processing for reasons relating to your particular situation.
